PART I  
PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Wildlife Conservation (Financial Contribution to Tanzania Wildlife Protection Fund) Regulations, 2019.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires-

“Act” means the Wildlife Conservation Act;

“Administrative Secretary” means a person who manages day to day activities of Tanzania Wildlife Protection Fund;

“Board” means the Board of Trustees of the Tanzania Wildlife Protection Fund established under section 92 of the Act;

“Director” means the Director of Wildlife appointed under

section 7 of the Act;  
“Fund” means the Tanzania Wildlife Protection Fund;  
“Institutions” means the College of African Wildlife Management (CAWM) established under the College of Wildlife Management Act, Tanzania Wildlife Research Institute (TAWIRI) established under the Tanzania Wildlife Research Institute Act, Pasiansi Wildlife Training Institute and Likuyu - Sekamaganga Community Based Conservation Training Institute and National Taskforce Anti-poaching;  
“Minister” means the Minister responsible for matters relating to wildlife.

## PART II FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Financial contribution

3. The Tanzania National Parks (TANAPA), Tanzania Wildlife Management Authority (TAWA) and Ngorongoro Conservation Area Authority (NCAA) shall each contribute 3% of their annual gross income to the Tanzania Wildlife Protection Fund.

Modality of contributions

4.-(1) For the purposes of Regulation 3, the financial contributions shall be made quarterly.

(2) The payment shall be made every preceding quarter, unless the Minister, by notice in writing determines otherwise.

Objectives of the financial contribution

5. The Fund shall ensure that the financial contributions obtained are used to implement the functions of the fund as well as facilitating and supporting crosscutting issues in wildlife conservation and management particularly in:

- (a) national, regional and international law enforcement campaigns and cross border anti-poaching operations including Wildlife Protection intelligence led operations;
- (b) assessment and payment of consolations;

- (c) establishment and upgrading of Protected Areas;
- (d) support community initiated projects to rural areas adjacent to wildlife protected areas;
- (e) facilitate capacity building, wildlife research, census and provide conservation education;
- (f) support reviewing of wildlife policy and legislation;
- (g)
- (h) coordination, monitoring and evaluation of the implementation of wildlife policy and Legislations.
- (i) coordination and management of regional and international obligations such as treaties and conventions;
- (j) facilitation and coordination of government trophies management;
- (k) any other activity related to conservation of Wildlife.

Management and distribution of the financial contribution

6.-(1) The financial contributions made pursuant to these Regulations to the Fund shall be distributed according to-

- (a) the approved budget of research and training institution;
- (b) the approved budget of the National Taskforce Anti-poaching;
- (c) the approved budget of secretariat of the fund; and
- (d) any other activities as per regulation 5.

(2) The Fund shall be responsible for the financial management accrued from these regulations.

Books of accounts

7. The Fund shall keep and maintain books of accounts and records of the operations and utilization of the financial contributions obtained pursuant to these Regulations in accordance with the acceptable accounting standards.

Auditing

8. The financial contributions to the Fund shall be annually audited by the internal Auditors from the Ministry,

Controller and Auditor General or such other person registered as an Auditor under the relevant law appointed for the purpose by the Controller and Auditor General on such terms and conditions as the Controller and Auditor General may determine.
